FEC RELEASES FINAL REPORT ON 1986 CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON — The Federal Election Commission has released its final Report on campaign finances in the 1986 Congressional elections. The Report provides a variety of statistical information which is summarized below.

*Total spending in Congressional races grew by 20.5% over 1984 levels.

While this increase is greater than the 9 percent growth in spending between 1982 and 1984, it is less than increases between other election cycles. From 1980 to 1982, spending rose by about 43%, and from 1978 to 1980, spending was up by 23%. The following chart shows financial activity by all candidates for Senate and House races for five election cycles:

*Spending by Senate candidates increased 24.1% from two years ago.

Senate candidates spent \$211.7 million, up from \$170.5 million in 1984. The slightly more than 24% growth between the '84 and '86 election cycles is generally consistent with the increase between 1982 and 1984.

*Disbursements in House races rose 17.5%.

While this is a marked difference from the 0.2% drop in spending between 1982 and 1984, it is worth noting that there were numerous "open seat" House races in 1986, due to retirements and incumbents who sought other elective offices. This factor accounts for much of the increase in financial activity.

*PAC contributions to '86 Congressional candidates grew by 26% over 1984 levels.

The amount of PAC money received by House and Senate campaigns totalled \$132.7 million and represented 28% of all moneys raised in Congressional races. Total PAC contributions for five past election cycles appear below, in dollar amounts and as a percentage of total funds raised:

*The cost of winning a Congressional seat continued to rise in 1986.

An analysis of winning House campaigns shows a nearly 19% increase in funds spent over 1984, \$172.7 million as compared with \$144.8 million two years ago. Winning Senate candidates spent 6 percent more, \$106.8 million in 1986, \$100.9 million in 1984. Figures below detail amounts spent for winning races in six election cycles:

8 Information on the following pages provides details of the various sources of monies raised by campaigns according to party affiliation and candidate status. A pie graph illustrates the sources of Senate and House receipts. The graph is followed by a chart showing average disbursements by House campaigns, based upon candidate status and the margin by which candidates either won or lost. The fifty largest campaigns, in both the Senate and House, also are listed. The final table gives information on the financial activity of general election Senate candidates over a six year period.

The following notes should be read in conjunction with the tables contained in this release:

1) Net receipt and disbursement figures are total receipts and disbursements, (as reported by the campaigns), minus any money transferred between committees within a campaign.

2) Non-Party Contributions columns contain PAC contribution information as reported by PAC's . (Previous FEC releases on the 1985-86 elections used summary figures reported by the candidates' campaigns.) The figures cited in this release are more accurate and are comparable to those used in previous cycles.

3) Caution should be used when trying to interpret data on candidate contributions and candidate loans. Variations in reporting may cause these fields to be inflated since loans which have been forgiven often appear in both columns. Any attempt to determine the total amount of financial support by candidates for their own campaigns should include a detailed examination of all reports filed by the campaigns in question.

4) Latest cash-on-hand figures are as of December 31, 1986, or the last report filed by the candidate's campaign.

5) Major party expenditures are monies spent by the National and State party committees of the two major parties on behalf of their candidates in the general election ONLY. There are limits on what the parties may spend. These expenditures are in addition to direct contributions.

6) Open Seat Races are those in which the incumbent did not seek re-election.

7) Receipts and Disbursements columns on the table for Senate activity over a six-year period are net of transfers between committees within the Senate campaigns. The transfer column includes proceeds from joint fundraising activities and amounts transferred from committees authorized by the candidate for a different federal office, e.g. House.




