## FEC REPORTS ON 1990 SENATE CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON -- Forty-five candidates for U.S. Senate races in 1990 raised \$29.3 million and spent \$9.6 million in the first six months of 1989, according to a release today by the Federal Election Commission.

By comparison, in the first six months of 1987, forty candidates for '88 Senate races had raised almost \$25 million and spent \$5.4 million.

The latest FEC summary provides an overview of money raised and spent for incumbent Senators since their last election in 1984, or from the time a 1990 committee was registered. Also included are any 1990 challengers who have registered and filed financial reports.

Reports for the 1990 contenders reveal that individuals have contributed \$19.4 million, or 66% of the monies raised thus far. PAC's have given almost \$8 million, or 27%.

Most of the candidates report sizeable cash balances as they head into the last half of the non-election year, with amounts ranging from a high of \$3.7 million, to a low of \$135,000 for incumbents; and from \$640,000 to zero for challengers. The average cash balance for incumbents was \$954,000, with more than half of all incumbents having over \$600,000. The average challenger's cash balance was \$166,000, with half having more than \$175,000.

Thirty-two incumbents are seeking re-election in 1990. Ten challengers (in eight races) have reported financial activity. There are currently two open seat races - Colorado and New Hampshire - with a combined total of three registered candidates.

The table included in this release lists each Senate candidate with total

receipts and disbursements for each two-year election cycle. Transfers of money within a campaign (where a candidate has more than one committee) have been subtracted. Contributions from individuals, PAC's, and the candidates also are listed for each cycle.\* The cash-on-hand and debts owed by each campaign are provided for each cycle from December 31, 1984, through June 30, 1989.

Some of the financial activity reported during the six-year period may relate to a prior election and should not automatically be presumed to be part of a candidate's 1990 election effort. The computerized information may be supplemented by researching the actual reports, which are on microfilm at the FEC.

The next financial filing by Senate candidates will be the 1989 year-end report, due on January 31, 1990. It will cover activity for the last six months of 1989.

\*PAC contributions for 1986 and 1988 are as reported by PAC's. All other information is taken from the summary pages of the reports filed by the candidates' campaigns.
