1990 SENATE CANDIDATES SPEND \$28 MILLION

WASHINGTON -- Candidates seeking election to the U.S. Senate in 1990 have reported raising \$62 million and spending \$28 million during 1989. As they entered 1990, the 70 campaigns were armed with more than \$47 million in cash.

In a report issued today, the Federal Election Commission provided statistical summaries for each of 31 incumbents and 29 challengers who have registered for the '90 campaigns. In addition, the FEC chronicled 10 candidates who have reported financial activity in the three open-seat races in Colorado, Idaho, and New Hampshire.

Twenty-two candidates reported receipts in excess of \$1 million. The top eight raised over \$2 million, with four of those exceeding the \$3 million mark. Nine candidates spent more than \$1 million; in fact, four exceeded \$2 million. Fifteen candidates had more than \$1 million cash-on-hand as they entered the election year. Twelve candidates reported raising more than one-half million dollars from PAC's. Rankings of the top campaigns are contained in this release.

The FEC has also provided a statistical breakdown of the money raised and spent by Senate candidates during 1983 in these same states. At that time, 12 candidates had raised over \$1 million, three had spent over \$1 million, and six had over \$1 million cash reserve entering the 1984 election year. The top five PAC recipients had raised less than \$400,000 from such sources.

A summary table attached to this release details fundraising and spending in the six years since these seats were last up for election. The FEC concentrates analysis on the current two-year election cycle, since financial activity in prior years is often related to retiring past campaign debts. In fact, this year's class of Senate incumbents raised and spent \$12 million in 1985-86, indicating that very little was saved from their early efforts to put toward the '90 elections.

Finally, an historical overview has been provided for spending in past election cycles by incumbents seeking re-election in 1990.
