PAC ACTIVITY REBOUNDS IN 1991-92 ELECTION CYCLE -UNUSUAL NATURE OF CONTESTS SEEN AS REASON-

WASHINGTON -- Rebounding from relatively stagnant levels of financial activity in the two previous election cycles, political action committee contributions to federal candidates rose 19%, according to a new study released today by the Federal Election Commission.

According to the FEC's report, PAC's contributed \$188.7 million to federal candidates between January 1, 1991 and December 31, 1992. Most of that money, \$179.2 million, was given to candidates seeking election in 1992.

Also, for the first time since 1977, PAC's drew on surplus funds from previous years to spend more than they raised. During the 1991-92 election cycle, PAC's raised \$385 million and spent \$394 million. Even after spending \$9 million more than they raised, cash reserves on December 31, 1992 totalled \$95 million. While fundraising was up only 4%, spending grew more than 10%, compared to 1989-90.

Much of the increase in PAC activity may have been due to an unusual combination of factors at work in the 1992 elections - making it a more active and competitive election cycle: reapportionment and redistricting, a large number of House retirements, special Senate elections in Pennsylvania, California and North Dakota, another open-seat Senate race in California, and a set of Senate seats which have, characteristically, been highly competitive.

Of the \$179.2 million contributed to '92 races, incumbents received \$126.3 million, challengers were given \$21.5 million, and open seat candidates, \$31.4 million. The following table shows the distribution of contributions over four election cycles. Keep in mind that the percentages are in part determined by the number of campaigns of each type that exist in each election cycle. In 1992, for example, there were 75 House districts where an incumbent never sought reelection (open seat), compared to 40 such districts in 1990. Only 371 House incumbents sought reelection in 1992, compared to 409 in 1990.

In terms of party distribution, Democrats received \$115 million; Republicans, \$64 million. Other party candidates were given just over \$300,000. Partisan breakdowns are somewhat different in elections to the two Chambers. The following chart provides percentages for four election cycles.

Less than \$800,000 in PAC contributions went to Presidential candidates in 1991-92, the least amount contributed since 1976.

In addition to the \$179.2 million contributed to '92 candidates, PAC's made independent expenditures of \$10 million to influence elections. More than \$8 million was spent on behalf of various candidates; another \$2 million against them. In Congressional races, this spending increased from \$4.35 million in 1989-90, to just over \$6 million in 1991-92. By contrast, in Presidential campaigns, independent spending dropped from \$13.6 million in 1987-88, to just \$4 million in 1991-92.

The following pages provide comprehensive data on PAC financial activity for the 1991-92 election cycle and comparable summary statistics for six previous election cycles. Rankings of the "Top 50" PAC's follow the tables. The tables on pages 6-7 show the distribution of PAC's by total amount spent and total contributed to candidates. These tables show, for example, that while 40% of all PAC's spent less than \$5,000 each, the 1.5% which spent more than \$1 million represented almost 41% of all PAC spending.

The FEC Reports on Financial Activity, 1991-92: Party and Non-Party Political Committees, Final Report will be published this fall, and will provide details on each political committee registered with the Commission.

(NOTE: This release pertains only to PAC activity for federal election purposes. New FEC regulations, effective January 1, 1991, require PAC's to also report all money raised and spent for shared federal and non-federal activities. During 1991-92, PAC's reported raising and spending \$7.7 million for the non-federal share of such activities. This activity is NOT part of this release.)






Summary of PAC Activity 1980-92
