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## 1991-92 CONGRESSIONAL SPENDING SOARS TO \$680 MILLION -Special factors at play cause spending to jump 52%-

WASHINGTON -- Congressional campaign spending rose 52% to reach an all time high of \$680 million during the 1991-92 election cycle, according to the Federal Election Commission's Final Report.

The FEC Report confirms previously released figures showing that from January 1, 1991, to December 31, 1992, U.S. Senate and House campaigns raised \$659.3 million and spent \$679.7 million. They ended the cycle with cash balances of almost \$60 million and reported \$81.6 million in debts.

Increased financial activity in the 1991-92 election cycle was influenced by congressional redistricting and the departure of an unusually high number of House incumbents. In addition to two special Senate elections in Pennsylvania and North Dakota, 1992 saw two Senate races in California. A large number of competitive races and an increased number of well-funded non-incumbents contributed to the dramatic upsurge in financial activity.

Compared to the 1989-90 election cycle, 1992 House campaign receipts increased 39%, to \$396 million, while spending rose 53%, to \$408 million. Incumbent House candidates spent substantially more than they raised, (over \$14 million), causing their ending cash balances to fall to \$44.2 million - the lowest level since the end of 1984.

House candidates, especially non-incumbents, contributed or loaned their campaigns more money than in previous cycles. Records show that House candidates contributed and/or loaned \$54.4 million to their own efforts, more than twice that contributed and/or loaned by candidates in 1989-90 races.

In Senate contests, candidates raised \$263.4 million, spent \$272.1 million, and ended the cycle with \$12.3 million cash-on-hand and debts totalling \$32.4 million. Individual contributions represented 62% of receipts - \$162.8 million, while PAC contributions of \$51.2 million equalled only 19%. Comparison of overall activity between different Senate election cycles is difficult because Senate elections are for staggered six-year terms, involve different areas of the country and, for this election cycle, involved two large California contests.

Although PAC contributions increased 19% - from \$149.7 million in 1989-90, to \$178.6 million in 1991-92 - the percentage of total receipts they represented fell for both Senate and House campaigns. The following chart provides the amounts and percentages of PAC contributions in Congressional campaigns over a 16-year period.

Overall summary data is furnished for all Congressional campaigns and for general election campaigns only on tables attached to this release. The information provided is presented for incumbents, challengers and open-seat candidates, as well as by political party. Comparison figures are provided for three previous election cycles. Median disbursement figures are given for certain categories of House campaigns and the amount spent per vote in Senate races since 1988. Six-year statistics are offered for each Senate race. Rankings of the top 50 candidates are also furnished in various categories.

## FOOTNOTES

1. Figures in the first two Tables and the detailed listing of candidates cover from January 1, 1991, or whenever the campaign registered during the election cycle, through December 31, 1992, or the last report filed by the campaign, as indicated.
2. Net receipt and net disbursement figures are total receipts and total disbursements, as reported by the campaigns, minus any money transferred between committees of the same campaign.
3. Columns entitled "PAC Contributions" are monies contributed to campaigns as reported by the PAC's making contributions. For candidates who won special elections in 1991 or 1992, these contributions have been divided between the special and regular election processes based upon the date of the contribution. If that date is more than 20 days after the special election, then the contribution is included in the regular election information for that candidate.
4. Open seat races are those in which the incumbent did not seek reelection. As such, both general election candidates in the 14 districts where the incumbent was defeated in the primary are classified as challengers. The two general election candidates in Ohio's 1st district and the 7th district in New Jersey are also listed as challengers. In these two cases, the incumbent decided to retire after receiving his party's nomination for reelection. Districts where special elections were held at times separate from the regular election calendar (AZ/2; MA/1; IL/15; PA/2; TX/3; and VA/7) have been divided into two races. Special election activity appears in tables referring to all campaigns and is included in the open seat category. Regular election activity of winners of the specials appear in the incumbent category, and their activity begins with the first report following the Post Special filing. The districts in which a special election is being held in conjunction with the general (old NY/17 which became NY/8; and NC/1) are classified as open seat and have not been divided.
5. Percentage figures in Tables covering several election cycles represent the percentage of net receipts from each source and will not sum to 100, since not all sources of receipts are listed.
6. On the Senate listings, the column titled "Candidate Support" includes contributions by the candidate, as well as loans made or guaranteed by the candidate. The column titled "Trans from other auth" includes monies transferred from House committees of candidates for the Senate, as well as proceeds from joint fundraising activity among several candidates or committees. Contributions from individuals and PAC's made through these joint fundraising efforts are NOT included in the "Individual Contributions" or "PAC Contributions" columns.
7. Some House members who are or were running for the Senate in '90 changed their former House campaign committees into their Senate campaign committees. Financial activity related solely to their Senate campaigns cannot be isolated. (See Dorgan, ND; Aucoin, OR; Campbell CO; Moody WI; Owens UT).
8. Activity of House Other Party candidates primarily reflects the campaigns of Bernard Sanders in Vermont, Lynn Taborsak in Connecticut, and Carlos Romero-Barcelo in Puerto Rico.
9. Information regarding candidate contributions and loans from the candidate for House Republican Challengers is significantly affected by the campaign of Michael Huffington in California. He contributed \$5.2 million to his campaign, 80% of all candidate contributions in that campaign type.
