PENNSYLVANIA COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS NAMED TO NATIONAL ELECTION ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Pennsylvania Commissioner of Elections William P. Boehm has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an entity of the Federal Election Commission and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the nation. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on methods of allocation of resources that will best serve the needs of election officials.

The Advisory Panel meets annually in selected cities. Commissioner Boehm is scheduled to participate in the 1994 session in Tucson, Ariz., June 19-21, at which more than 150 state and local election officials are expected.

Mr. Boehm is Commissioner of the Pennsylvania Bureau of Commissions, Elections, and Legislation in Harrisburg, a post he has held since 1987. He began as a legal assistant at the Bureau in 1972. From 1985-87, he was a research associate with the Public Employee Retirement Study Commission.

Mr. Boehm holds a bachelor of science degree in Social Science Education from Indiana University of Pennsylvania and a master of arts degree in American Studies from Pennsylvania State University.
