## PAC CONTRIBUTIONS TRACK 1992 LEVELS

WASHINGTON -- A report issued today by the Federal Election Commission shows that PACs contributed \$109.9 million to federal candidates between January 1, 1993, and June 30, 1994. Of that total, \$100.8 million was given to candidates seeking election in 1993-94. By comparison, PACs contributed \$112.1 million during the first 18 months of the 1991-92 election cycle, with \$102.9 million going to 1992 candidates.

According to the FEC, PACs raised a total of \$285.5 million and spent \$244.3 million for the first 18 months of the 1993-94 election cycle. Cash remaining to begin the last six months of the election year was \$136.1 million. The FEC report was based on an examination of 4,513 political committees.

Of the \$109.9 million contributed by PACs, incumbents received \$91.1 million, challengers were given \$5.5 million, and open seat candidates, \$13.3 million. Of the \$112.1 million contributed during 1991-92, incumbents received \$91.6 million, challengers, \$8.2 million, and open seat candidates, \$12.3 million.

A twelve-year overview of the percentage of PAC contributions given during similar 18-month periods to House incumbents, challengers and open seat candidates is attached to this release. The figures in this table are limited to PAC contributions given to candidates seeking election in those cycles.

Comparable 18-month summary figures for PAC receipts, disbursements, and contributions to federal candidates, cash-on-hand, and debts are provided for seven previous election cycles.

Comprehensive data on PAC financial activity for the first 18 months of the 1993-94 election cycle follow, including rankings of the "Top 50" PACs.
