## 1996 SENATE CAMPAIGNS UNDER WAY

WASHINGTON -- Candidates seeking election to the 33 Senate seats up for election in 1996 have reported raising about \$24 million and spending \$10 million during the first six months of 1995.

Although comparisons of Senate races are difficult because of their diversity, mid-year reports filed by this year's class of 49 candidates indicate less fundraising activity than the first six-month filings by candidates in the past three election cycles. In 1989, the last cycle the same seats were up for election, 45 candidates reported raising \$29.3 million and spending \$9.5. During the first half of 1991, 55 candidates reported raising \$33.3 million and spending \$10 million. Fifty Senate campaigns in 1993 raised almost \$25 million and spent \$7 million.

From January 1, through June 30, 1995, contributions from individuals accounted for \$17 million, or 70.8% of the total raised by Senate candidates. PAC money totaled \$5 million and represented 20.8% of receipts.

Candidates began the second half of the non-election year with \$25 million cash-on-hand and debts of \$1.3 million, which may relate to previous elections.

The attached pages provide summary statistical information on each candidate. Financial activity for 1991-92 and 1993-94 is also included, where available.

The next reports for Senate campaigns are due January 31, 1996, and will cover the last six months of 1995.
