FEC RELEASES 6-MONTH HOUSE FUNDRAISING FIGURES: REPUBLICANS REPORT LARGE GAIN

WASHINGTON -- According to recent reports filed with the Federal Election Commission, 435 House incumbents reported receipts of \$45.5 million during the first six months of 1995. This represents an \$11.5 million increase from the comparable period for incumbents in 1993. For the first half of 1995, 232 Republicans reported raising \$28.1 million, while 202 Democrats raised \$17.4 million.

Republican incumbents reported median receipts of \$110,203 compared to \$64,691 for Democrats. During the comparable period in 1993, Republicans reported median receipts of \$63,290 and Democrats reported \$69,598.

Republican freshmen were responsible for much of the increased fundraising. Receipts for the 73 Republican freshmen totaled \$10.4 million compared to \$1.2 million for the 15 Democratic freshmen. Median receipts for Republican freshmen were \$123,104 while median receipts for Democratic freshmen were \$72,971.

Non-incumbents raised a total of \$3.2 million during the first six months of 1995, with 24 Democrats raising \$1.6 million and 50 Republicans raising a similar amount. In the first six months of 1993, 44 Democrats raised only \$.4 million, while 78 Republicans raised \$2.3 million.

Included in this release are the rankings of House members for the following categories: total receipts, contributions from individuals, PAC contributions, disbursements, cash on hand and debts owed. Debts may relate to the last election.
