PACs CONTRIBUTE \$78 MILLION TO 1995-96 CONGRESSIONAL CAMPAIGNS

WASHINGTON -- Political action committees contributed \$78 million to congressional candidates during the first 15 months of the 1995-96 election cycle, according to the Federal Election Commission. This was an increase of just over \$8 million, or 12%, when compared to the same period in the 1993-94 election cycle.

The FEC information indicates that PACs contributed a total of \$90.8 million to all federal candidates during the 15-month period, with \$10.5 million contributed to candidates seeking to retire debts or to raise money for future elections. PACs also contributed \$2.2 million to Presidential candidates.

The FEC examined 4,294 political committees from January 1, 1995, through March 31, 1996, and found that PACs had raised \$248.6 million and spent \$199.6 million. Cash on hand for all PACs at the end of the calendar quarter was \$143.4 million.

The following chart depicts 15-month PAC activity in congressional races since 1977-78, when the FEC began its computerized studies.

Republican congressional candidates received \$44.8 million from PACs, while Democratic congressional candidates received \$33.2 million. During the same period in 1994, Democratic candidates received \$46 million from PACs and Republicans received \$23.7 million.

Incumbents received \$65.1 million during the first 15 months of the 1996 cycle, up from \$61 million in 1994. PACs gave \$13 million to non-incumbents by March 31, 1996, compared with \$8.7 million two years earlier.

Corporate PACs led all categories in contributions to 1996 congressional candidates by giving \$30.7 million, followed by trade/membership/health, \$21.5 million; labor \$15.6 million; non-connected, \$7.2 million; corporations without stock, \$1.7 million, and cooperatives, \$1.4 million.

The information on the following pages provides more detail on PAC finances. The first table compares 15-month PAC activity for six election cycles. Contributions made during the current cycle (overall and for '96 races only) are provided for Presidential, Senate and House candidates by political party and type of candidate (incumbent, challenger, and open seat).

Rankings of the largest PACs follow the tables. Included in these rankings are the PACs with the largest increases in contributions to federal candidates, as well as the PACs with largest declines.
